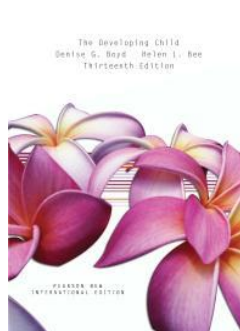
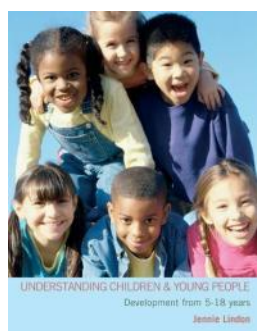
## Books:
