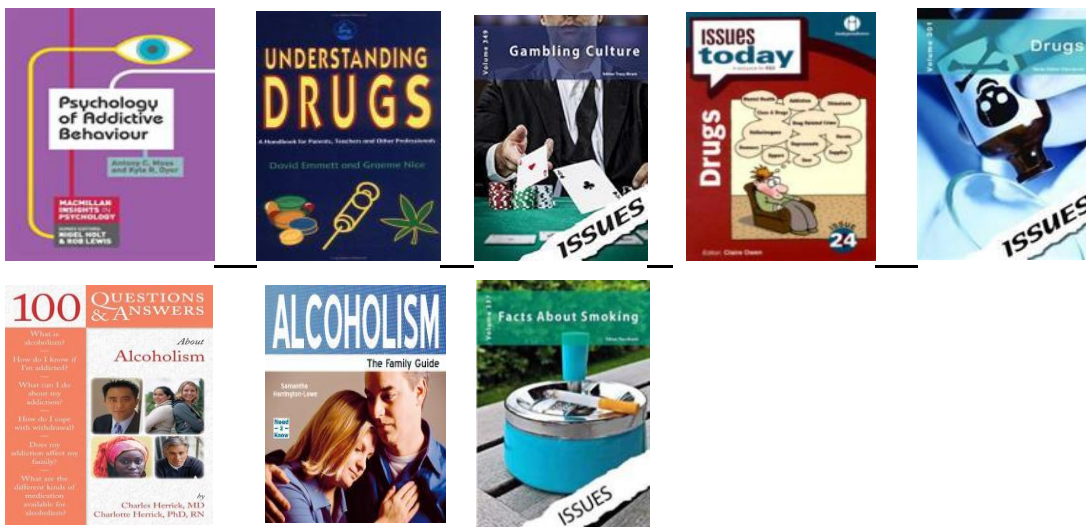


# Addiction

Addiction books can be found on the Library shelves on or around the classification number **362, 362.29** mainly.

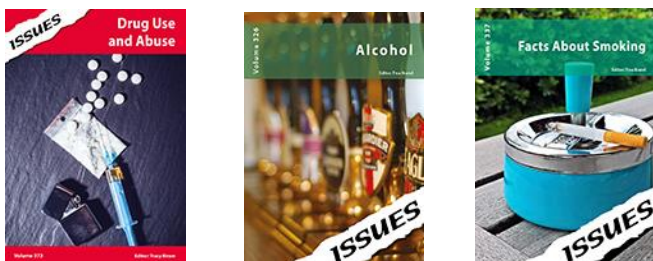
